
We have a faculty council which comprises of the entire teaching staff of that department. The Deans calls the meeting at regular intervals, particularly before the allocation of the courses. Teachers concerned with a particular course is asked his / her experience of the content, pedagogy and students response. Based on such inputs, minor changes are made in the course structure. A detailed restructuring of all courses in the programme is done after



every three years. As a NBA accredited institute, the program has formulated its Programme Educational Objectives, Programme Outcomes and Course Outcomes. The course outcomes are decided by the faculty concerned which should be in tune with the PO and further to PEOs and mission and vision. The expected CO is matched with the attained outcome and significant variations are looked into.

The students' involvement is sought by periodical feedback for every course. Every class has two class representatives from whom weekly feedback is taken.

As a standalone institution approved by AICTE, JIMS Rohini Sector-5 is offering this tuition fee waiver to the students of Economically Weaker Section (EWS) category. (Parents whose annual income is not exceeding Rs. 8, 00,000). Under this scheme the number of seats is limited to 5% (9 Seats in PGDM, 3 in PGDM RM, 3 in PGDM IB) of the approved intake. These seats will be over and above the sanctioned intake. The competent authority in this category is the State Government or its designated authority. TFW is in addition to our need-come-merit based scholarship program.
