**Minutes:**

To check the improvement in intake quality the result of the graduation mark of student of PGDM programme was compiled and kept in three categories, above 70%, between 60% to 70%, and below 60%.

The result is mixed with wide fluctuations.


**MCA:** The yardstick is slightly different. It is above 75% for 1<sup>st</sup> Category.

## Placement

It was also decided to find a link between academic result and the placement quality. In PGDM programme, a list of top 50 students in academic result and in placement record (CTC with salary) was compiled in which it was found that 24 students from 2016-18 batch and 25 students from 2017-19 batch were in common which shows high correlation between academic performance and corporate expectation about our students. It further proves that our academic delivery is fairly in tune with employability.
